1. Following pie chart gives a percentage distribution of time spent on various activities in the last 30 days. What would be the number of hours spent travelling in a month?

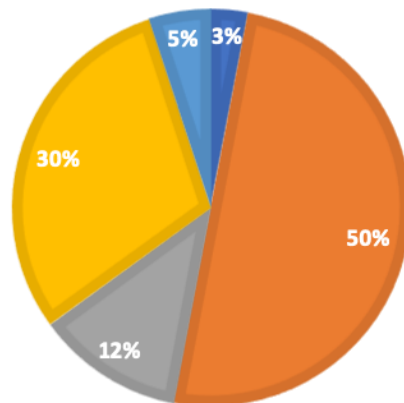

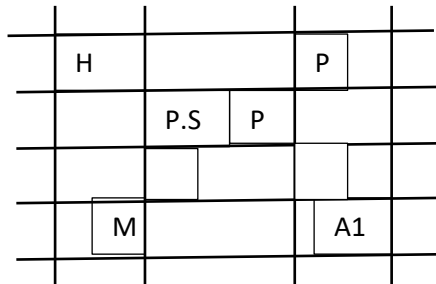
